



Kicking Strap Adjuster – Made Simple

On various rigs styles it is not uncommon to see where things could be done in a more simple and clean fashion, for better ease of secure adjustment and less chance of foul ups.

The Kicking Strap is one of those items that stands out. Often big, bulky and over engineered without being able to be adjusted easily on the go. Locking wheels or nuts are often used to secure settings but small adjustments are hard to accurately set and usually require two hands.

Let's keep things simple. This can be done with silicone tubing that has an internal diameter smaller than the adjustment screw. Cut into a short 12-15mm length, this can be slid over the barrel section, then the screw can be adjusted back in place.





A clean and simple method that sits nicely in current designs where getting in to adjust can be a little tricky.
